School Transport September 2020/21

As we start to put plans into place for a return to normal in September we are aware that this may not be the case and we continue to await further guidance from the Government regarding this. As part of the process we have been looking at transport to school and are planning for this along the same lines as this current school year.

We have agreements in principle with all our providers that the same school services will be offered in the next school year. I must stress this is subject to social distancing and other Government guidelines and we will of course keep parents fully updated of all developments as and when we receive them.

We are also in constant contact with South Yorkshire Transport Passenger Executive (SYPT) and Doncaster LA in planning for September and again any updates will be shared with parents.

As a School we will continue to offer subsidised services in the 3 areas that are not covered by First Buses or Nottinghamshire County Council. These three routes which are organised by McAuley are listed below:

Route 1	Commencing at Campsall then stopping at Toll Bar and Bentley and then directly on to school
Route 2	Commencing at Denaby Main then stopping at Conisbrough, Sprotbrough and then directly on to school

Route 1 and 2 will only run in the morning and pupils will have to make their own way home in the afternoon. Although the services will be subsidised by McAuley there will be a fee £17.27 per month per pupil for this service. This will have to be paid a month in advance to reserve a place.

Route 3	Commencing at Tickhill straight to McAuley and then a return in the afternoon from McAuley to Tickhill

The cost of this service is £58.81 per month per pupil. This will have to be paid a month in advance to reserve a place.

All payments will commence on the 1st of the month starting in September.

Please email mallison@mcauley.org.uk by 26th June with your child's name and form and which route you wish to book onto.

Booking on these services will be on a first come, first serve basis. Once you have reserved the seat you will receive further information.
