## **Expectations**

I promise to observe the high standards expected of all senior students. I will:

- actively **support the Catholic ethos of the school** and **respect** <u>all</u> members of the school community, regardless of their role.
- aim for 100% attendance; any absence will be unavoidable. I will NOT take holidays during term time (exceptions made in extenuating circumstances only).
- be **punctual** and leave the sixth form in time to get to lessons in plenty of time
- follow safeguarding procedures including signing in/out and wear a lanyard/badge
- wear sixth form uniform correctly
- strive for 'Excellent' Attitude to Learning.
- work purposefully in 'STUDY' periods and 'go above and beyond' by reading around the subject, working hard on extended learning tasks; actively seeking additional support and attending support/intervention sessions when needed.
- meet all course requirements\*. I will meet coursework deadlines, sit external examinations, controlled assessments and practical work that I am entered for\*\*, complete exam preparatory notes to a high standard, complete homework tasks, seek and catch up missed work, work in an organised way, manage folders and bring in correct equipment etc.
- \* School reserves the right to remove students from subjects if course requirements are persistently not met or there is persistent underperformance with a significant risk of failure.

  \*\*Students will be charged the entry fees for any examinations or controlled assessments they are entered for but do not sit without a valid reason.
  - 'get involved' in wider sixth form life and participate in extra-curricular courses such as First Aid, MOOCs, British Sign Language, work experience and show initiative by eg starting a club or organise a charitable event
  - respect school resources and buildings and report any damage; accidental or otherwise.
  - not bring energy drinks or take-away food into school

Sixth Form students observe these expectations at all times when representing the school. This includes travelling to/from school, trips, work experience as well as during school time.

On the rare occasion that a student repeatedly makes poor choices, the school reserves the right to review their place in the sixth form.
